Ave for a disorderly conduct. Dispatch advised there was a intoxicated party inside the resturant attempting to fight with other customers.

Upon arrival, we walked into Red Wok. As we were walking in, the group of males were carrying what appeared to be an intoxicated male out the front door. I observed a customer inside the restaurant from the front entrance. I could not see inside the entire store at the time.

While Officer BECKER and I had a confrontation with the party outside, I observed at least 4 customers who were dressed in suits and dresses arriving and entering the restaurant. The time during that time was approximately 0045 hours. The party who carried the intoxicated male outside stated they were from a gang called G-Loc. The party also appeared intoxicated. Before we left, the party returned inside Red Wok. We asked the staff at Red Wok if they wanted us to trespass the party. The staff stated no and that they could return into the restaurant.

PUBLIC NARRATIVE

On 04/09/17 at 0010 hours, police were sent to Red Wok, 1626 White Bear Ave for a disorderly conduct. Upon arrival as police were walking into Red Wok, police observed multiple males carrying what appeared to be a very intoxicated male. The intoxicated male was shirtless and appeared to be unconscious but breathing. After carrying the male out to the vehicle, multiple males returned to the front of Red Wok. There were a confrontation with police and the individuals, who then stated they were from a gang called G-Loc. The group of males, who were intoxicated returned inside Red Wok. While police were on scene, police also observed customers arriving and going into Red Wok.
