Dear Saint Paul Property Owner,

You are receiving this letter because you have indicated to the City that you believe the delinquent charge for garbage services at your property 666 PORTLAND AVE is in error. We have reviewed your request and have determined that the charge for your garbage service was not made in error. The following is the reason for the charge.

REASON FOR CHARGE:

According to the information provided by Republic Services, they do not have a record of a service hold on file for your property. Additionally, service holds may not be used to avoid paying for service if a residence is occupied.

Garbage haulers have turned all delinquent charges for Quarter 4 2018 (October – December) over to the City for assessment. When a delinquent balance is turned over to the City, your account with the garbage hauler will show a zero balance. The city is now responsible for collecting that amount. If you made a payment to your garbage hauler after January 5th, 2019, that payment was applied as a credit on your account. You are still responsible for paying the City any outstanding delinquent balance from Quarter 4 2018.

OPTIONS TO PAY YOUR BILL

You can pay your bill before it is assessed to the property so it does not incur additional charges. Payment can be made by any of the following methods:

1. Pay online from your checking/savings account at www.stpaul.gov/assessments. No additional fee.
2. Pay online using a credit/debit card at www.stpaul.gov/assessments. Bank fee of 2.49%.
3. Pay in person with the City of Saint Paul Assessment Section at 700 City Hall, 15 W. Kellogg Blvd., St. Paul.
4. Mail payment to the address below and include your name and property address.

If the City of Saint Paul Assessment office does not receive payment for the delinquent charges by the due date, the City will assess any outstanding charges to the property.
