


HOMELESS YOUTH IN ST PAUL


- ➤ Over 2000 homeless children in St Paul Schools
- > 378 with families
- > 27 unaccompanied minors
- > Over 1500 invisible



- ➤ 138 Dedicated emergency shelter beds for families
 - ➤ 105 families with children
 - ➤ 33 Unaccompanied minors
- 611 Dedicated emergency shelter beds for single adults

Current Shelter Capacity

Shelter Capacity Doesn't Meet the Need



- The gap between the number of families waiting and the families receiving shelter continues to increase, from six families in 2015 to 29 in 2018.
- The average length of time a family waits for shelter was 32.3 days for priority families and 44.3 days for families without priority.

Current Homeless Initiatives

- RUSH 11 housed
 - 10 pending approval
- Outside/In 13 housed
 - 16 pending approval
- Regional unsheltered homeless meetings
 - Recommendations on a regional level
