NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Sound Level Variance Special Olympics Summer Games University of St. Thomas

Dear St. Paul Property Owner:

This is to inform you of a request for a variance from the sound level limitations as indicated in the St. Paul Noise Ordinance (Chapter 293 of the St. Paul Legislative Code). Property owned by you and located near the noise source, may be affected by this variance request. <u>Rental property owners must provide a copy of this notice to all renters or</u> <u>post a copy in a common area of the building so it can be viewed by the occupants.</u>

Description of Variance:

Location: O'Shaughnessy Stadium at the University of St. Thomas, 2115 Summit Avenue

Noise Source: Special Olympics MN, Mark Anderson, has requested a sound level variance in order to present announcements and live music at O'Shaughnessy Stadium at the University of St. Thomas, with a requested sound level limit of 97 dBA at 100 feet from the sound source, beginning Thursday, June 20 from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Friday, June 21 from 7:30 a.m. to 10:00 p.m., Saturday, June 22 and Sunday, June 23, 2018, from 7:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. The Department of Safety and Inspections will be recommending the following conditions: 1) The Variance shall be for Special Olympics Summer Games on Thursday, June 20, Friday, June 21, Saturday, June 22, and Sunday, June 23, 2019. 3) All electronically powered equipment, PA system, loudspeaker or any similar device used in conjunction with the event, will not exceed 90 dBA, as measured 50 feet from any stage or sound source used for music and/or announcements between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on June 20; from 7:30 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. on June 21; and from 7:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on June 22, and June 23, 2019. 4). The Applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 5).
