
In the event a fire alarm is sounding or beeping anywhere in the building, look for smoke or flames. If no smoke or flames can be detected, call your landlord at (651) 492-4478, or Margaret Anderson at (651) 208-6136. *Tenants are forbidden to open, alter, or tamper with smoke detectors.* If an alarm sounds, or smoke or flames are detected, follow these procedures:

- Assist any person in immediate danger to safety, if it can be accomplished without risk to yourself.
- Immediately call 911. It is best to have the fire department respond and not be needed than to have them arrive too late for potential rescue.
- If the fire is small enough, use a fire extinguisher or other fire control method to control and extinguish the fire. Do not fight a fire if the following conditions exist:
 - o You don't know what's burning.
 - The fire is spreading rapidly.
 - You don't have the proper equipment.
 - You can't do so with your back to an exit.
 - The fire might block your means of escape.
 - You might inhale toxic smoke.
 - Your instincts tell you not to do so.
- If the first attempts to put out the fire do not succeed, evacuate the building immediately by following the evacuation route.
- Doors, and if possible, windows, should be closed as the last person leaves a room or area to prevent the fire from spreading.
- Upon evacuation of the building, all should proceed to a designated meeting area where head counts can be taken.
- Never reenter a burning building without permission from the fire department.

Smoke detectors are located where an "X" appears above.

CO detectors are located where an O appears.

Detectors may be tested by depressing the button located thereon. An audible alarm should briefly sound to indicate that it is functioning.

If a detector's low-battery tone sounds, or its power light fails, please contact your landlord.

Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 299F.362, subd. 6(b), it is a misdemeanor to willfully disable a detector or causes it to be nonfunctioning.
