## NOTICE OF CONDEMNATION UNFIT FOR HUMAN HABITATION ORDER TO VACATE

RE: 600 BEAUMONT ST Ref. # 105360

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on November 26, 2018.

The building was found to be unsafe, unfit for human habitation, a public nuisance, a hazard to the public welfare or otherwise dangerous to human life. A Condemnation Placard has been posted on the building.

The following deficiency list must be completed or the building vacated by the re-inspection date.

A reinspection will be made on or after February 25, 2019.

CONDEMNATION OF THE BUILDING REVOKES THE CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY.

Failure to complete the corrections may result in a criminal citation. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy.

## DEFICIENCY LIST

1. Building - Condemned - SPLC 34.23, MSFC 110.1 - This occupancy is condemned as unsafe or dangerous. This occupancy must not be used until re-inspected and approved by this office.-The building is condemned due to, but not limited to damage from explosion at 676 Payne.

2. Interior - Gas - SPLC 34.14 (2), 34.34 (5) - Provide an approved gas service adequate to meet the buildings needs. This work may require a permit(s), call DSI at (651) 266-8989.

3. Interior - Throughout - SPLC 34.14 (2), 34.34 (5) - Provide an approved electrical service adequate to meet the buildings needs. This work may require a permit(s), call DSI at (651) 266-8989.

4. Interior - Throughout - SPLC 34.10 (2), 34.34(1) - Repair and maintain the damaged structural member. This repair may require a building permit, call DSI at (651) 266-8989.-Have a structural analysis of the building done due to explosion at 676 Payne.

5. Interior - Throughout - SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.17 (5) - Repair and maintain the ceiling in an approved manner.

6. Interior - Throughout - SPLC 34.11(4), 34.35(1), MPC 601.1 - Provide an adequate water supply to all water closets, sinks, showers and tubs.

7. Windows - Where needed - SPLC 34.09 (4), 34.33 (3) - Repair and maintain the window in good condition.

8. SPLC 39.02(c) - Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
