Your building was inspected on May 7, 2019 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date.

A re-inspection will be made on June 11, 2019 at 12:30 PM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Interior Basement NEC 300.11 Provide for all raceways, boxes, cabinets, and fittings to be securely fastened in place. -There is a conduit with a switch box that is loose and unsecure in the private storage room in the basement. Properly secure the conduit.
- 2. Interior Garage MSFC 605.4 Discontinue use of all multi-plug adapters.
- 3. Interior Garage MSFC 605.5 Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.

- 4. Unit 1 & 6 Bathroom SPLC 34.11 (1), MSBC 2902.1, SPLC 34.35 (1), MPC 301.1 Repair or replace and maintain all parts of the plumbing system to an operational condition. -The toilet is loose and unsecured. Secure the toilet and seal around the bottom.
- Unit 2 Windows SPLC 34.09 (4), 34.33 (3) Repair and maintain the window in good condition.
 The top sash for the bedroom window does not stay up and slams down. Also, the slide rails on the side is damaged at the bottom.
 The top sash for the living room window is unable to close all the way and does not line up and latch.
- 6. Unit 6 Doors SPLC 34.33 (3) Repair and maintain the door in good condition. The deadbolt for the basement door does not work because the frame is incomplete and the latch does not align. Properly fix the frame and deadbolt. The door knob for the top basement door is loose.
- 7. Unit 7 Back Entry Door MSFC 703.1 Provide, repair or replace the fire rated door and assembly. The minimum rating must be: -20 minutes. The back-entry door does not latch.
- 8. Unit 7 Back Room MSFC 1030.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room or area, or discontinue use of area as a sleeping room. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.-The back room is not an approved sleeping area. The room does not exit directly to the outside.
- 9. Unit 7 Back Room SPLC 34.23, MSFC 110.1 This occupancy is condemned as unsafe or dangerous. This occupancy must not be used until re-inspected and approved by this office. -The back room for Unit 7 has been condemned because there is no egress window in this room. The back room does not exit directly to the outside, it leads to another corridor.
- 10. Unit 7 Strobe Lights SPLC 34.12 (2), SPLC 34.36 (1) Repair and maintain all required and supplied equipment in an operative and safe condition to properly and safely perform their intended function in accordance with the provisions of the applicable code. -The visual strobe lights connected to the smoke alarms is not working properly. Repair, replace or properly remove.
