Your building was inspected on June 10, 2019 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date.

## A re-inspection will be made on July 8, 2019 at 11:00AM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

#### DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Basement Fuse Box SPLC 34.14 (2), 34.34 (5) Provide an approved electrical service adequate to meet the buildings needs. This work may require a permit(s), call DSI at (651) 266-8989.
  - -Fuse box not working properly and missing various fuses, electricity not adequate to all areas of the building.
- 2. Basement MSFC 605.6 Provide electrical cover plates to all outlets, switches and junction boxes where missing.

- -Open junction boxes throughout the basement.
- 3. Basement MSFC 605.5 Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.
  -Extension cords used throughout the property. In the basement to provide lighting for

illegal bedroom

- 4. Basement MMC 603.9, 604 Repair, maintain or install proper insulation and duct sealant in compliance with the mechanical code. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.
  - -Various duct work throughout the basement had duct tape for the seals.
- 5. Basement SPLC 34.11 (1), SBC 2902.1, SPLC 34.35 (1), MPC 301.1 Provide an approved number and type of plumbing fixtures.
  -Drain in the basement sink is not proper.
- 6. Basement MSFC 1030.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room or area, or discontinue use of area as a sleeping room. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.

  -Discontinue use of the illegal basement bedroom immediately.
- 7. Basement MN Stat. 299F.362 Immediately provide and maintain a smoke detector located outside each sleeping area.

  -No smoke or carbon monoxide alarm in the basement.
- 8. Lower Apartment Bathroom SPLC 34.14 (2) c Repair or replace the duplex convenience outlet with ground fault protection within 3 feet of the basin on an adjacent wall in all bathrooms. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989. -GFI reads open ground.
- Lower Apartment Bedroom MSFC 1030.2 Remove the materials that cause an exit obstruction. Maintain a clear and unobstructed exit path.
   -Egress window blocked in the bedroom.
- Lower Apartment Throughout SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.17 (5) Repair and maintain the walls in an approved manner.
  -Various holes in the walls throughout the lower apartment.
- Lower Apartment MSFC 605.6 Provide electrical cover plates to all outlets, switches and junction boxes where missing.
  -Missing outlet covers throughout the lower apartment.
- 12. Lower Apartment MN Stat. 299F.362 Immediately provide and maintain a smoke detector located outside each sleeping area.
  -Hardwired smoke was missing from the ring. Various battery operated smoke alarms missing from the rings.

- 13. Lower Apartment MSFC 1008.1.9.3 The maximum number of locks on unit doors is two. Remove all locks in excess of two.

  -Too many locks on entry doors.
- 14. Lower Apartment Throughout MSFC 605.1 Repair or replace damaged electrical fixtures. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.

  -Multiple damaged light fixtures throughout the property.
