## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

## Podium Sports- Minnesota Half Marathon Sound Level Variances

Dear St. Paul Property Owner:

This is to inform you of a request for a variance from the sound level limitations as indicated in the St. Paul Noise Ordinance (Chapter 293 of the St. Paul Legislative Code). Property owned by you and located near the noise source, may be affected by this variance request. <u>Rental property owners must provide a copy of this notice to all renters or post a copy in a common area of the building so it can be viewed by the occupants.</u>

## **Description of Variance:**

**Location:** Shepard Road at Eagle Parkway, Start Line, and Shepard Road west of Ontario Street (east end of Upper Landing Park), Finish Line

**Noise Source:** Podium Sports Marketing, Minnesota Half Marathon has applied for two sound level variances, at a requested sound level limit of 85 dBA at no specified distance, in order to present announcements and music at Shepard Road and Eagle Parkway for the starting line, and amplified music and announcements at Shepard Road west of Ontario Street (east end of Upper Landing Park) for the finish line. The MN Half Marathon is to be held on Saturday, August 3, 2019, from 6:45 a.m. until 11:00 a.m., with a pre-event sound check at 6:30 a.m., and 8:00 a.m. until 11:30 a.m. with a pre-event sound check at 7:00 a.m. The Department of Safety and Inspections recommends the following conditions: 1) The Variance shall be for the hours of 6:45 a.m. until 11:00 a.m., with a pre-event sound check at 7:00 a.m. on Saturday, August 3, 2019. 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 85 dBA as measured 50 feet from any sound source used for music and/or announcements. 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 11:30 a.m. on the date of the event.
