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NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Sound Level Variance Application Revision Medtronic Twin Cities Marathon State Capitol Complex, 75 Rev Doctor Martin Luther King Jr Boulevard

Dear St. Paul Property Owner:

This is to inform you of a request for a variance from the sound level limitations as indicated in the St. Paul Noise Ordinance (Chapter 293 of the St. Paul Legislative Code). Property owned by you and located near the noise source, may be affected by this variance request. <u>Rental property owners must provide a copy of this notice to all renters or post a copy in a common area of the building so it can be viewed by the occupants.</u>

Description of Variance:

Location: 75 Rev Doctor Martin Luther King Jr Boulevard

Noise Source: Twin Cities in Motion has submitted a revised application for Saturday activities for a sound level variance in order to provide amplified sound for announcements, speakers and/or music at the Medtronic Twin Cities Marathon. The request is for the hours of 7:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m., with a pre-event sound check from 6:30 a.m. until 7:00 a.m. on Saturday, October 5, 2019 and from 7:30 a.m. until 2:30 p.m., with a pre-event sound check from 7:15 a.m. until 7:30 a.m. on Sunday, October 6, 2019 at the State Capitol Complex area, 75 Rev Doctor Martin Luther King Jr Boulevard. The Department of Safety and Inspections recommends the following conditions: 1) Variance will be for the hours of 7:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m., with a pre-event sound check at 7:00 a.m. on Saturday, October 5, 2019 and source. 3) The applicant will provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices will be turned off no later than 12:00 p.m. on Saturday, October 5, 2019 and no later than 2:30 p.m. or Sunday, October 6, 2019, the dates of the event.
