Zoning Variance Application Description

The Highland Village Montessori School has purchased the adjoining property at 1886 Highland Parkway, PID 162823210089. The school is proposing to raze the existing structures on the site and construct a new 3-story, 8,249 square foot daycare building.

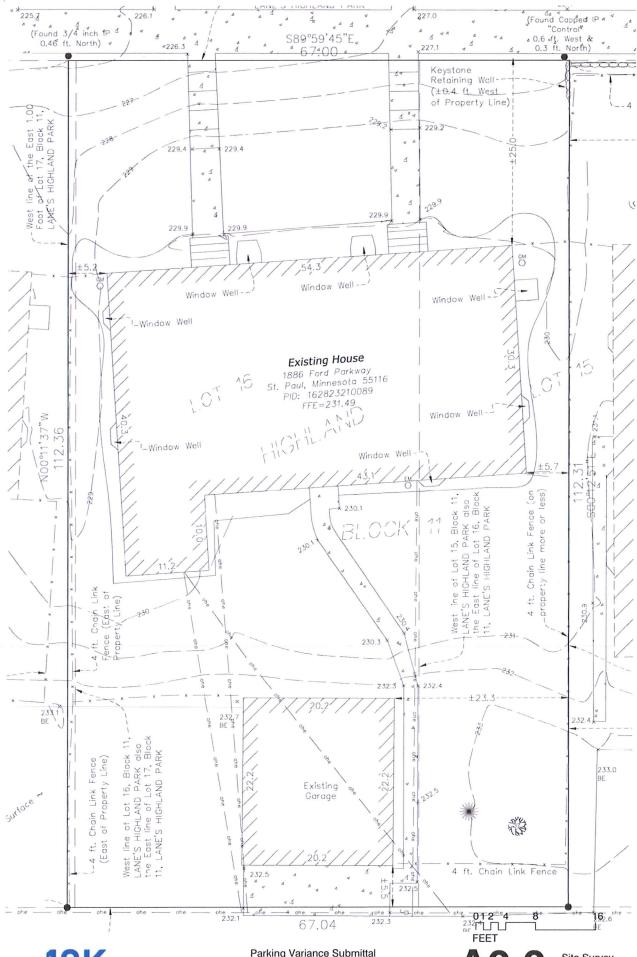

#### Parking:

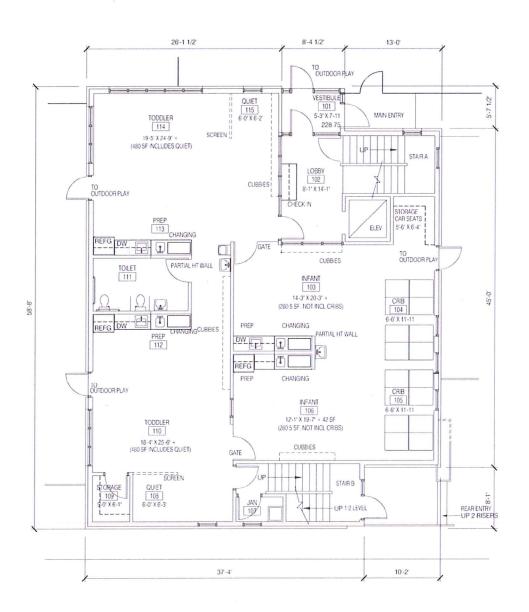
The proposed plan does not meet the required 12-spaces. Based on the current site configuration, only 6-spaces are provided. Per information provided by the school owners, the staff currently uses a variety of other transportation methods to arrive at the site, including public transportation, walking, or being dropped-off at the facility. The facility is located on a bus route and walking or biking can be done via public sidewalks and streets.

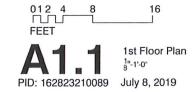

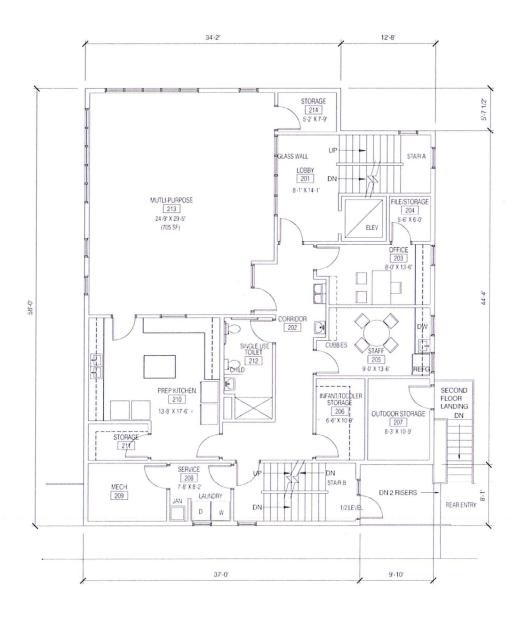


1 FIRST FLOOR PLAN

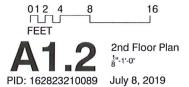


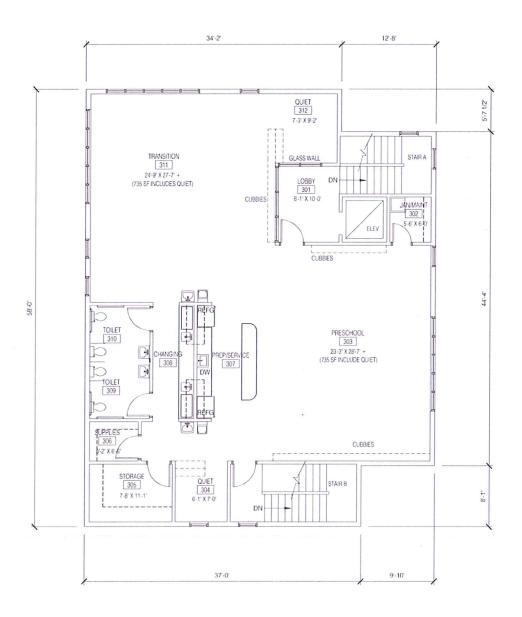


1 SECOND FLOOR PLAN 1/8"-1"-0" SECOND FLOOR AREA 2 563 SF

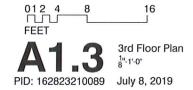


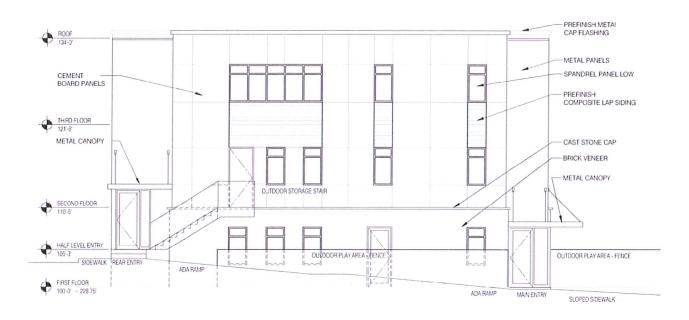


1 THIRD FLOOR PLAN

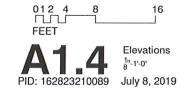


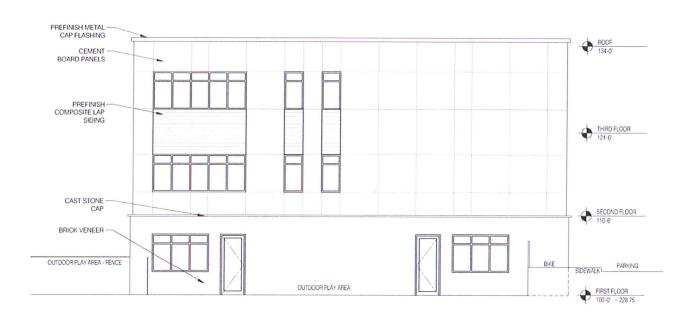




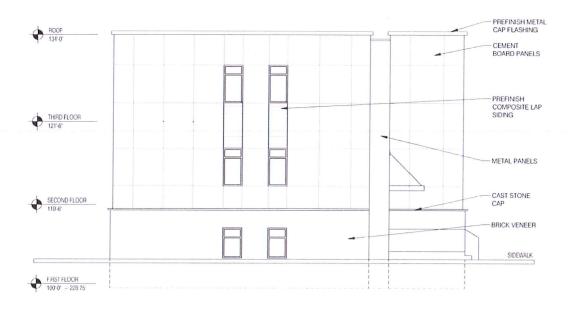






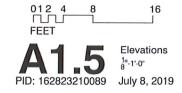


1 WEST ELEVATION 1/8'-1'-0'



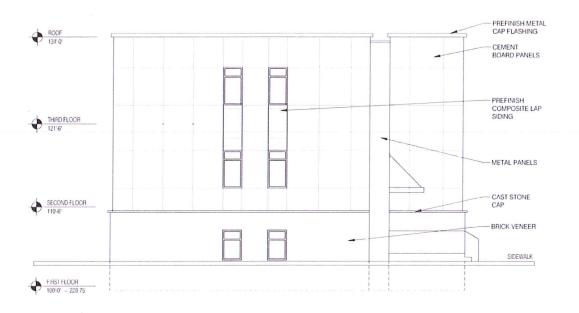
SOUTH ELEVATION

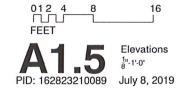

## Resolution to Support the Parking Variance at 1886 Ford Parkway
