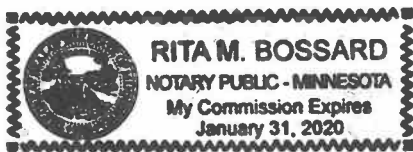

NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Licensee:

The Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) is recommending adverse action against the Auto Repair Garage and Auto Body Repair licenses held by SKD Auto Tek LLC d/b/a SKD Auto Tek for the premises located at 80 Cottage Avenue West in Saint Paul. The basis for this recommendation is as follows:

Saint Paul Legislative Code Section 310.05 (m)(1) sets the penalty for a first-time violation of the conditions placed on a license at \$500.

On May 5, 2019 the Department of Safety and Inspections received a complaint of the poor conditions of this property. On May 8, 2019, an inspector from the Department of Safety and Inspections came to 80 Cottage Avenue West for an inspection and photographed and documented a number of violations including:

- Vehicles parked in a gravel area that is not permitted for storage or parking.
- Vehicles double parked and not parked in accordance with the site plan.
- Extensive exterior storage.
- Trash.
- Improperly stored oil, engines, barrels, and vehicle fluids.
- A vehicle with major body parts missing.
- Repair work being done on a vehicle outside of the garage.

On May 13, 2019 the Department of Safety and Inspections sent you an Enforcement Notice that laid out the steps you needed to take in order to be in compliance with your license conditions. This notice set a compliance date of June 14, 2019.

On July 3, 2018, the inspector returned for a re-inspection and found that many of the same violations observed on May 8, 2019 still existed and found you to be in violation of license conditions #1, #5, #3, #6. Specifically these conditions state:

1. *All customers, business, and employee vehicles must be parked in accordance with the approved site plan on file with Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) dated 5/11/2012. A maximum of twenty-one (21) vehicle may be parked on the exterior of the property at any time."*
2. *"The storage of vehicles for the purpose of salvaging parts is expressly forbidden. All vehicles parked outdoors must appear to be completely assembled with no major body parts missing. Vehicle salvage is not permitted."*
3. *"There shall be no exterior storage of vehicle parts, oil or any other similar materials associated with the business. Trash will be stored in a covered dumpster. Storage of vehicle fluids, batteries, etc. shall be in accordance with Ramsey County Hazardous waste regulations."*
4. *"No repair of vehicles may occur on the exterior of the lot or in the public right-of-way (e.g., street, sidewalk, boulevard, etc.). All repair work must occur within an enclosed building."*

This is your first (1st) violation and pursuant to Saint Paul Legislative Code § 310.05 (m) (1), the licensing office will recommend a \$500.00 matrix penalty.

You have four (4) options to proceed:

1. If you do not contest the imposition of the proposed adverse action, you may do nothing. If I have not heard from you by **Tuesday, August 27, 2019** I will presume that you have chosen not to contest the proposed adverse action and the matter will be placed on the City Council Agenda for approval of the proposed remedy.
2. You can pay the \$500.00 matrix penalty. If this is your choice, you should send your payment to the Department of Safety and Inspections at 375 Jackson Street, Ste. 220, St. Paul, MN 55101-1806 no later than **Tuesday, August 27, 2019**. A self-addressed envelope is enclosed for your convenience. Payment of the \$500.00 matrix penalty will be considered a waiver of the hearing to which you are entitled.
3. If you wish to admit the facts but you contest the penalty, you may have a public hearing before the Saint Paul City Council. You will need to send me a letter with a statement admitting to the facts and requesting a public hearing no later than **Tuesday, August 27, 2019** the matter will then be scheduled before the City Council to determine whether to impose the \$500.00 matrix penalty. You will have an opportunity to appear before the Council and make a statement on your own behalf.

4. If you dispute the facts outlined above, you may request a hearing before an Administrative Law Judge (ALJ). You will need to send me a letter disputing the facts and requesting an administrative hearing no later than **Tuesday, August 27, 2019**. At that hearing both you and the City will appear and present witnesses, evidence and cross-examine each other's witnesses. After receipt of the ALJ's report (usually within 30 days), a public hearing will need to be scheduled. At that time, the City Council will decide whether to adopt, modify or reject the ALJ's report and recommendation.

Please note: If you choose an administrative hearing, the Department of Safety and Inspections reserves the right to request that City Council impose the costs of the administrative hearing per Saint Paul Legislative Code § 310.05 (k).

If you have not contacted me by Tuesday, August 27, 2019, I will assume that you do not contest the imposition of the \$500.00 matrix penalty. In that case, the matter will be placed on City Council Consent Agenda for approval of the recommended penalty.

Condition #1. All customer, business, and employee vehicles must be parked in accordance with the approved site plan on file with the Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) dated 5/11/2012. A maximum of twenty-one (21) vehicles may be parked on the exterior of the property at any time. **Vehicles were parked in the gravel area, which isn't permitted for storage or parking. Vehicles were double parked and not parked according to the site plan.**

Condition #3. There shall be no exterior storage of vehicle parts, tires, oil or any other similar materials associated with the business. Trash will be stored in a covered dumpster. Storage of vehicle fluids, batteries, etc. shall be in accordance with the Ramsey County Hazardous Waste regulations. **Extensive exterior storage was present. Trash was present on the property. Oil, engines, barrels, and vehicle fluids did not appear to be stored properly. Large dark patches were present on the gravel and the rear gravel area smelled of petrochemicals. This issue was referred to Ramsey County-orders were issued.**

Condition #5. The storage of vehicles for the purpose of salvaging parts is expressly forbidden. All vehicles parked outdoors must appear to be completely assembled with no major body parts missing. Vehicle salvage is not permitted. **Major body parts were missing on at least one vehicle. See photos.**

Condition #6. No repair of vehicles may occur on the exterior of the lot or in the public right-of-way (e.g., street, alley, sidewalk, boulevard, etc.). All repair work must occur within an enclosed building. **A hood was up on a vehicle, indicating that repair work was taking place outside.**

Timeline

- **7 May 2019 Received complaint.** Complaint says: "Auto repair looks like a junk yard. Vehicles with missing parts and tires at fence."
- **5 May 2019 Received complaint.** Complaint says: "Property in poor condition, tires."
- **8 May 2019 Inspected property.** Tires and vehicle parts stacked along fence, too many vehicles, vehicle missing major body part.
- **13 May 2019 Sent enforcement notice** with compliance date of June 14, 2019.
- **14 May 2019 Received complaint.** Complaint says: "Excessive vehicles"
- **16 May 2019 Received complaint.** Complaint says: "Tires, scrap wood, oil bottles, barrels, auto parts and debris throughout the entire fenced property."
- **3 July 2019 (19 days after comply date) Reinspection.** Found to be in violation of condition 1, 3, 5, and 6. See photos.

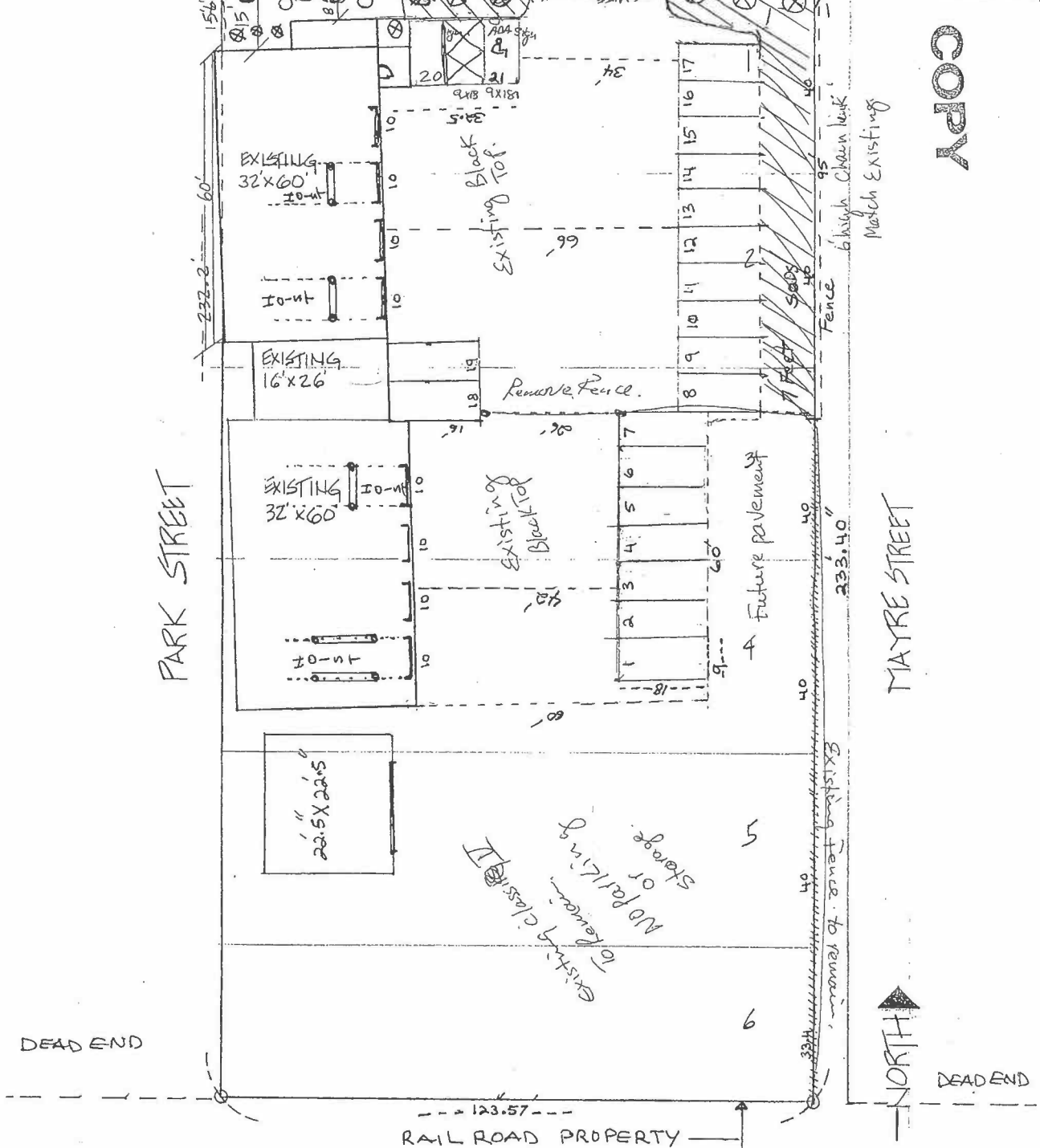

Dear Licensee:

The City of Saint Paul Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) recently received a complaint regarding outdoor storage at the above referenced property. On May 8, 2019, an inspection was performed. During the inspection, it was observed that the business was not in compliance with condition one, three, and five attached to the Auto Repair Garage and Auto Body Repair Shop licenses.

Condition one states that all vehicles must be parked according to the site plan on file with DSI dated 5/11/2012. During the site visit, it was noted that vehicles were not parked according to the site plan on file. Specifically, vehicles in excess of the limit of 21 were parked on the property. Vehicles were parked in the drive lane and were parked in the gravel area on the south side of the property. No parking nor storage is permitted in this area.

Condition three states that there shall be no exterior storage of vehicle parts, tires, oil, or other similar materials associated with the business and that trash shall be stored in a covered dumpster. During the inspection, it was observed that the fence along the east side of the property was lined with tires and various vehicle parts were stored on top of the tires.

Condition five states that all vehicles on the exterior of the property must be completely assembled with no major body parts missing. A minivan parked outside one the property was missing a rear window.

Orders

You must reduce the number of vehicles parked outside to twenty-one (21) and must park according to the approved site plan. All tires and vehicle parts stored outside must be removed. All vehicles parked outside must appear to be completely assembled with no major body parts missing. A reinspection will occur on or after June 14, 2019 to ensure compliance with all license conditions. If the licensed premises is found to be out of compliance at that time, this matter will be forwarded to the City Attorney's Office for adverse action.
