8 9	That chapter 88 of Saint Paul Legislative Code is hereby amended as follows:
10 11	Chapter 88. – Water Code—Meters
12	Sec. 88.10. – Damaged meters and metering systems.
13 14 15	(a) If any part of the metering system is damaged, either through neglect or carelessness of the consumer, the cost of repairs, or replacement if beyond repair, must be paid for by the consumer or property owner.
16 17	(b) Lost or stolen meters or metering system components shall be replaced by the water utility at the expense of the consumer or property owner.
18 19	(c) It is unlawful to tamper with, disconnect or remove the meter, register, radio transmitter, cable or remote meter reading device.
20	(d) Except for the cable, the cost of ordinary maintenance and repairs will be
21	the responsibility of the water utility.
22	(e) In case of breakage, stoppage or other irregularity in the meter, meter
23	setting or metering system, the <u>property</u> owner or consumer shall notify the
24	water utility immediately.
25	(f) Meters damaged due to freezing shall be repaired or replaced at the expense
26	of the eonsumer orproperty owner.
27	(g) Meters which have been damaged due to hot water and which were
28	installed with the required protective features will be repaired by the water
29 30	utility after the first damage from hot water. Subsequent damage due to hot water must be paid for by the consumer or owner unless further protective
31	measures are installed as required.
