At the end of this hearing, the Legislative Hearing Officer will make a recommendation to the City Council as to whether the license request should be approved or be referred to an administrative law judge for further review. The City Council will have the final authority to grant or deny the license.

1. Licensee agrees to take appropriate action(s) to ensure that the sale, display, and/or consumption of alcoholic beverages is contained to the indoor and outdoor area shown on the approved plan on file with the Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI).

2. Each year prior to the placement of table(s) and/or chair(s) in the public right-of-way (i.e., sidewalk), the licensee agrees to obtain a new Obstruction Permit from the Department of Public Works. Licensee agrees to maintain the sidewalk café in accordance with the conditions placed on an approved Obstruction Permit, acknowledges that an Obstruction Permit is effective on April 1 and expires on October 31 of each year, that table(s) and/or chair(s) may not be placed in the public right-of-way before or after the effective/expiration dates, and that a failure to comply with this condition will result in adverse action being taken against all of their licenses.

Dear Applicant:

Our review of your application for a license is in process. Notification has been sent to the community organization and neighbors for the area in which you intend to operate giving them until **Friday**, **September 27**, **2019** to voice any objections to your license application. If no objections are received, your license will be issued (pending any requirements not completely met) approximately one week past the date given above.

If objections are received a hearing will be scheduled before a legislative hearing officer. You will receive notice of the time, place and date of the scheduled hearing from the Legislative Hearing Officer. At that hearing, the hearing officer will take testimony from all interested persons and will make a recommendation to the City Council as to whether the license(s) should be approved or be referred to an administrative law judge for further review. The City Council will have the final authority to grant or deny this license application.

Requirements including the following must be met prior to the issuance of your licenses:

- Sign and return one copy of the enclosed license condition affidavit acknowledging the conditions that will be placed on your license(s). A return envelope has been included for your convenience.
- Provide proof of having obtained a restaurant license from the Minnesota Department of Health (MDH), who may be contacted at 651-201-4500 for information about their licensing process if you have not already done so.
- Contact DSI Senior License Inspector Kris Schweinler at 651-266-9110 to schedule the required in-house review of DSI's Liquor License Manual.
- For the Liquor Outdoor Service Area (Sidewalk) license:
 - O Complete the petition of support requirements as per the enclosed handout from the list of identified properties highlighted in yellow. Once DSI has verified the sufficiency of the petition we will forward this license type to the City Council for consideration of approval.
 - Obtain City of St Paul Public Works Right of Way Division approval by completing the following:
 - Submit a completed Obstruction Permit application with payment of the \$60 fee.
 - Submit a proposed sidewalk seating plan drawn in accordance with the enclosed Sidewalk Café Site Plan Standards handout. The proposed sidewalk seating plan you submitted was not sufficiently detailed.
 - Contacting Public Works Right-of-Way Inspector Bill Awker at 651-266-9804 to obtain approval of a sidewalk seating plan *after* submitting the Obstruction Permit application and a revised proposed seating plan.

NOTE: You may not place tables/chairs nor provide alcohol service in the public right-of-way until <u>both</u> Public Works and the City Council have granted their approval.
