If you have sent in an objection, you will receive notice of the time, place and date of the scheduled hearing. At that hearing, the Legislative Hearing Officer will take testimony from all interested persons. At the end of this hearing, the Legislative Hearing Officer will make a recommendation to the City Council as to whether the license request should be approved or be referred to an administrative law judge for further review. The City Council will have the final authority to grant or deny the license.

Recommended License Conditions:

1. Per City of Saint Paul Legislative Code 409.15(a)(2), On-sale wine license shall mean a license authorizing the sale of wine not exceeding fourteen (14) percent alcohol by volume, for consumption on the licensed premises only in conjunction with the sale and service of food (menu item only). The sale of Malt (Strong) will also take place only in conjunction with the sale and service of food.

2. Per City of Saint Paul Legislative Code 409.15(e), licensee must be able to show that gross receipts are at

least sixty (60) percent attributable to the sale of food.

3. Licensee will submit to the Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) annual gross receipts for food and

liquor for each year the license is renewed.

4. Per City of Saint Paul Legislative Code 411.02, the definition of Entertainment A is, "Amplified or nonamplified music and/or singing by performers without limitation as to number, and group singing participated in by patrons of the establishment." (includes karaoke). Entertainment A license does not allow for patron and/or performance dances.

5. Licensee agrees to close the establishment at 12:00 a.m. midnight. All patron/customers shall vacate the

premises by 12:30 a.m. each day of the week as per City Zoning Code (parking requirement).

Dear Applicant:

Our review of your application for a license is in process. Notification has been sent to the community organization and neighbors for the area in which you intend to operate giving them until Friday, November 29, 2019 to voice any objections to your license application. If no objections are received, your City license could be issued (pending any requirements not completely met) approximately one week past the date given above. The approved paperwork and City license will then be forwarded to the State of Minnesota Alcohol and Gambling Enforcement Division (AGED). You would then need to contact AGED to obtain your Buyer's Card (NOTE: AGED conducts an on-site inspection for a location that has not previously been licensed to sell Wine On Sale before they'll approve a Buyer's Card. AGED has stated they do not schedule an inspection until the City has completed its review of your application and sent them the approved paperwork). AGED will send you your City license once they have finished their review.

If objections are received a hearing will be scheduled before a legislative hearing officer. You will receive notice of the time, place and date of the scheduled hearing from the Legislative Hearing Officer. At that hearing, the hearing officer will take testimony from all interested persons and will make a recommendation to the City Council as to whether the license(s) should be approved or be referred to an administrative law judge for further review. The City Council will have the final authority to grant or deny this license application.

Requirements including the following must be met prior to the issuance of your licenses:

- Sign and return one copy of the enclosed license condition affidavit acknowledging the conditions that will be placed on your license(s). A return envelope has been included for your convenience.
- Obtain all necessary building and/or trade permits related to any construction work associated with the establishment of this use, and all required inspection approval(s) related to these permit(s). Only licensed trade contractors authorized to perform work in that trade (e.g., plumbing, electrical, ventilation, etc.) may obtain permit(s) and/or perform work in such trade.
- Provide proof of having obtained a restaurant license from the Minnesota Department of Health (MDH), who may be contacted at 651-201-4500 for information about their licensing process if you have not already done so.
- Contact Kris Schweinler, DSI Senior License Inspector, at 651-266-9110 to schedule the required in-house review of DSI's Liquor License Manual.
