- 2. Retaining wall Front of building SPLC 34.09 (2), 34.33 (3) Provide and maintain foundation elements to adequately support this building at all points.-
- 3. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
- 4. SPLC 34.19 Provide access to the inspector to all areas of the building.-
