Revocation of Fire Certificate of Occupancy and Order to Vacate

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was determined to be unoccupied on September 22, 2017. Since certificates are for the occupancy of buildings, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy.

Saint Paul Legislative Code provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. In order to re-occupy the building, the following deficiencies (if applicable) must be corrected and a complete Certificate of Occupancy inspection will be required.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. 1st Floor Fire Extinguisher MSFC 906.1, MN Stat. 299F.361 Provide approved fire extinguishers in accordance with the following types, sizes and locations.-Fire extinguishers must be permanently mounted between 3 and 5 feet high in readily visible and easily accessible locations. Mount the bracket in an unobstructed location for the loose extinguisher behind the bar. Provide approved bracket to hang the extinguisher next to the pizza oven where hanging by the hose.
- 2. 1st Floor Kitchen MSFC 906.1, MN Stat. 299F.361 Provide approved fire extinguishers in accordance with the following types, sizes and locations.-*Provide minimum 2A10BC rated fire extinguisher in addition to the K-Class extinguisher in rear prep kitchen.*
- 3. 1st Floor Kitchen MSFC 609.3.3 Kitchen Hood Maintenance Replace missing filters above the stoves on two hoods, filters must be in place over all sections of the hood.
- 4. Basement Walk-in Cooler MSFC 1030.2, 1008.1.8 Exit hardware *Repair broken/missing emergency release on walk-in cooler door.*

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
