Last week I met with DSI Director Ricardo Cervantes and Building Official Steve Ubl to review your Recommendations and Order on Cross Motions for Summary Disposition.

The City would respectfully request that count number 7 of its Notice of Violation be dismissed in the interest of efficiency.
