




SAINT PAUL REGIONAL WATER SERVICES YEAR TO DATE PRODUCTION



SAINT PAUL REGIONAL WATER SERVICES PRODUCTION BY MONTH




SAINT PAUL REGIONAL WATER SERVICES YEAR TO DATE CONSUMPTION

SAINT PAUL REGIONAL WATER SERVICES CONSUMPTION BY MONTH




