
Thank you for reaching out. I understand that assessments property taxes are difficult to manage in the best of times. I am responding primarily to make sure I understand the monthly increase you expect to have as it seems very high at \$500.

An assessment option is to have it included on your yearly property taxes over a 20 year period – this is the typical. This option does include interest that is determined when the bonds are sold (that is, after ratification of the assessment amount later this year, should the project be approved by Council). Spreading your assessment out over 20 years would give an montly increase of approximately \$23.40 (without interest - \$5,616 divided by 20 years divided by 12 months). Interest is typically paid each year as you go, that is, assuming a 5% (ball park guess) interest the first years interest would be \$23.40 per month (and would drop every year after). This gives an estimated total monthly cost of \$46.40. Please remember this is only an example.

I don't mean to dismiss an over \$500 additional cost in the first year on your mortgage payment, I do want to make sure we are in the same ball park.
