Hello Clare.

Thank you for providing a means for documenting the vacancy of my home in 2019. Attached are screen shots of my evidence.

For the time span of September 2019 thru February 2020, please note the dates of the building permit. If you enlarge the pictuure, the FINAL inspection dates are 2/23/2020 for the electrical and 2/28/20 for the plumbing. Since you may know, occupancy cannot occur until the FINAL inspection is signed off on by the City Inspectors.

Additional evidence shows the registration date into the Residence Inn as 2/19/2019 as well as a letter from my State Farm adjuster that shows Additional Living Expenses - which is temporary housing - ending January 31,2020. An additional claim pushed our reoccupancy date to March 1, 2020. Do you want proof of that claim? Again the FINAL inspection performed by a City of St Paul inspector is 2/28/20, per the building permit.

Attached also is a form with the heading "State Farm", that gives the date of loss as 2/1/2019 and the date of damage inspection as 2/9/2019 as a result of "Water Damage and Freezing".

I can accept the Jan - March 2019 bill as my responsibility. Clearly no one occupied my home beginning 2/19/19 until 3/1/2020. I have also included a picture taken July 30,2019 that shows my home down to studs - uninhabitable.

I received your voice message re the hearing date and time. I will be available. You also recited the correct phone number to reach me on that date.
