SECTION 2

Sec. 193.05. Just cause notice for tenants.

- (a) Just cause notice. A landlord may not issue a notice terminating tenancy unless the landlord is able to establish one or more of the following grounds:
 - (8) Complying with a government order to vacate. The landlord is complying with a government agency's order to vacate, order to abate, or any other order that necessitates the vacating of the dwelling unit as a result of a violation of Saint Paul city codes or any other provision of law. <u>The landlord shall provide</u> <u>Relocation Assistance to the tenant upon delivery of the written notice. If a</u> <u>substantially equivalent replacement unit is vacant and available in the</u> <u>building, that unit may be made available to the tenant at a substantially similar</u> <u>rental rate as the tenant's current lease.</u>

Sec. 193.12 Exemptions.

(a) Whenever local, state, or federal funding or loan requirements conflict with any portion of this Chapter, those funding or loan requirements will take precedence over only those portions in conflict. This subsection shall not be read to exempt properties from the requirements of this Chapter based on funding source alone.

SECTION 3

This Ordinance will take effect and be in force on JanuaryJuly 1, 2021 following its passage, approval, and publication.
