My name is Sabrina L Labor and I am the property owner at 925 Thomas Ave W, St Paul, MN 55104 (property ID: 35-29-23-21-0078).

I am writing in advance of the public hearing today at 3:30pm for [assessment # 190162](#), [file #CG1904E3](#), [agenda #51](#), [ver. 4](#), [file # RLH AR 20-42](#) regarding my 2019 Quarter 3 garbage bill delinquent payment.

I wanted to apologize for my oversight in not paying my quarter 3 garbage payment on time for the period of July to September 2019. I have since resolved the issue by setting up automatic quarterly payments to my checking account, effectively transferring the account to my name, and have paid the full delinquent amount on the St Paul Assessments website immediately upon receipt of the hearing notice (\$124.74).
