## Revocation of Fire Certificate of Occupancy and Order to Vacate

RE: 864 MARION ST

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on May 7, 2010, for the renewal of the Certificate of Occupancy. Since you have failed to comply with the applicable requirements, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy in accordance with Section 33.05 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code.

## A re-inspection will be made on May 12, 2010 at 11 am or the property vacated.

The Saint Paul Legislative Code further provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. Failure to immediately complete the following deficiency list or the building vacated may result in a criminal citation.

## **DEFICIENCY LIST**

- 1. Exterior SPLC 71.01 The address posted is not visible from street. (HN-1)-Provide reflective numbers or background or illuminate at night.
- 2. Exterior SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the door in good condition.-Repair or replace the damaged storm doors.
- 3. Exterior SPLC 34.09 (1) a, 34.32 (1) a Provide and maintain foundation elements to adequately support this building at all points.
- 4. Exterior SPLC 34.09 (1) b,c, 34.32 (1) b,c Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint.

- 5. Exterior SPLC 34.11 (8), 34.34 (4) Provide approved garbage containers impervious to weather.-Remove the freezer from the yard and provide approved trash containers.
- 6. Exterior SPLC 34.09 (2), 34.32(2) Repair or replace the unsafe stairways, porch, decks or railings in an approved manner. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.-Repair or replace both front and rear stairs/deck under permit.
- 7. Exterior SPLC 163.03, 163.01 (2), (3) Currently license (tabs) all vehicles on the property and return the vehicles to an operative mechanical condition or remove vehicles from the property.-Repair or remove inoperable vehicle with expired tabs and broken glass.
- 8. Exterior SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window glass.-Replace all cracked or broken windows throughout-Check all exterior windows.
- 9. Exterior SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Provide or repair and maintain the window screen.-Replace all torn and missing screens.-Check all exterior screens.
- 10. Exterior SPLC 34.08 (10) Repair, replace and maintain exterior sidewalks, walkways and stairs.
- 11. Interior SPLC 34.19 Provide access to the inspector to all areas of the building.
- 12. Interior SPLC 34.19 Provide access to the inspector to all areas of the building.
- 13. Interior-Unit 2 SPLC 33.05 Uncertified portions of the building must not be occupied until inspected and approved by this office.
- 14. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 15. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
