As owner or person(s) responsible for : 400 HATCH AVE you are hereby ordered to eliminate all nuisance conditions which are in violation of Chapter 45 of Saint Paul Legislative Code.

1. Cut and remove any overgrown vegetation (including trees) impeding public right of way, sidewalk, blvd, and alley areas. Public sidewalks must be cleared edge- to- edge and up to seven (7) feet in height. Alleys and streets must be cleared from edge- to- edge and up to fourteen (14) feet in height. PLEASE CUT OVERHANGING TREE VINES PROTRUDING ONTO ALLEY RIGHT- OF- WAY. THANK YOU! Comply before July 30, 2020

If you do not correct the nuisance or file an appeal before July 30, 2020 , the City will correct the nuisance and charge all costs, including boarding costs, against the property as a special assessment to be collected in the same way as property taxes.

Charges: If the City corrects the nuisance, the charges will include the cost of correction, inspection, travel time, equipments, etc. The rate will be approximately \$260 per hour plus expensed for abatement.

You must maintain the premises in a clean condition and provide proper and adequate refuse storage at all times

APPEALS: You may appeal this order and obtain a hearing before the City Council by completing an appeal application with the City Clerk before the appeal deadline noted above or seven (7) days after the date mailed, which ever comes first. No appeals may be filed after that date. You may obtain an appeal application from the City Clerk's Office, Room 310 in City Hall, 15 W Kellogg Blvd., St. Paul, MN 55102. The telephone number is (651) 266- 8688. You must submit a copy of this Summary Abatement Notice with your appeal application.
