I am wondering what information the City Council members are using to determine if the ACOP program is working effectively and worthy of renewal.

Why isn't there some form of evaluation included in the agenda? (Attachment B is not attached) Why is there no report of the evaluation of the program?

Have there been any complaints or concerns raised that need to be addressed in light of recent awareness of racial bias and excessive force by police officers toward people of color?

Where is the critical thought process? Reporting and evaluation are included in the amendment language, but where is it being utilized?

Where is the St. Paul Public Housing Crime Report?

There is supposed to be a monthly report. I searched on the internet many ways and was not able to find the Public Housing Crime Report. There are many other very comprehensive reports about St Paul crime, but not for the Public Housing Association.

We must actively work to end systemic racism and speak up for those citizens who are less likely to speak up for themselves.

The vote to renew this contract should be postponed until these questions are answered satisfactorily and it has been determined that progress is being made to serve the citizens in St Paul's public housing in an equitable and respectful manner.
