Revocation of Fire Certificate of Occupancy and Order to Vacate

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on July 22, 2020, for the renewal of the Certificate of Occupancy. Since you have failed to comply with the applicable requirements, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy in accordance with Section 40.06 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code. A reinspection will be made on August 7, 2020 at 2:00P.M. or the property vacated.

The Saint Paul Legislative Code further provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. Failure to immediately complete the following deficiency list or the building vacated may result in a criminal citation.

DEFICIENCY LIST

1. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.35 (3) - Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.-
2. SPLC 39.02(c) - Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
3. SPLC 34.19 - Provide access to the inspector to all areas of the building.-
