Noise Source: Kim O'Brien, Rice and Larpenteur Alliance, has applied for a sound level variance, with a sound level request of 100 dBA at no specified distance, in order to provide amplified sound outdoors for the Rice and Larpen Tour Event at 1675 Rice St. in the Strip Mall Parking Lot. on Saturday, Sept. 26, 2020 from 3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m., with a pre-event sound check at 2:00 p.m. The Department of Safety and Inspections recommends the following conditions: 1) the Variance shall be for Saturday, Sept. 26, 2020 and from 3:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m., with a pre-event sound check at 2:00 p.m. 2) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 85 dBA as measured at 50 feet from the sound source from the hours of 3:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m. Saturday, Sept. 26, 2020. 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 7:00 p.m. Saturday, Sept. 26, 2020 the date of the event.
