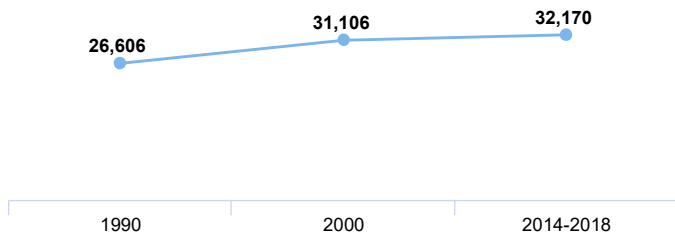

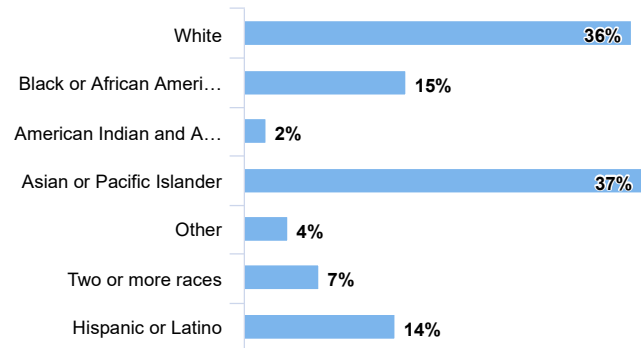

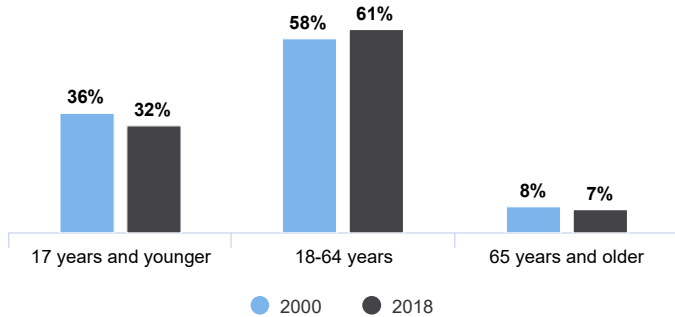
Total population



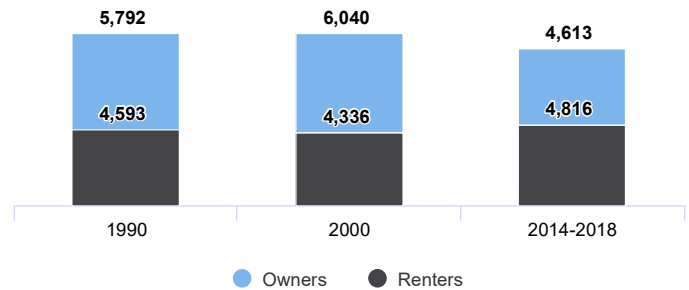
Population by race/ethnicity



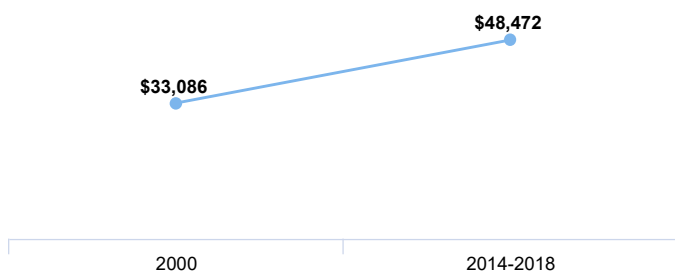
Population by age



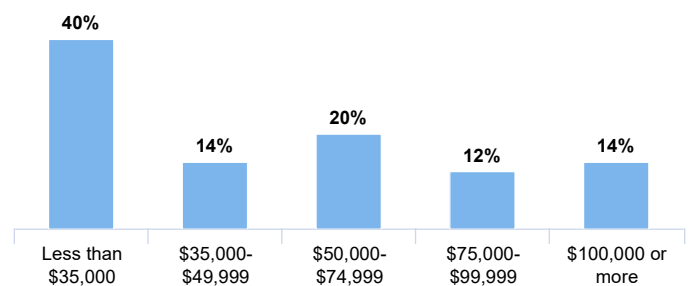
Households by tenure

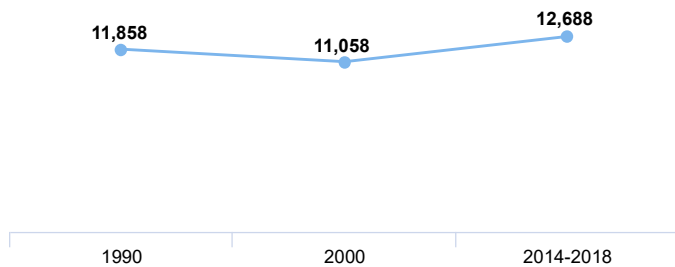

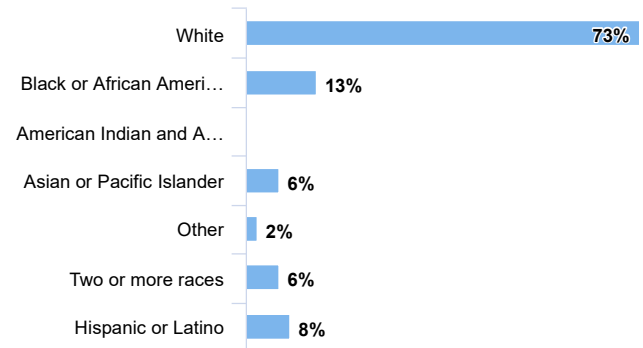

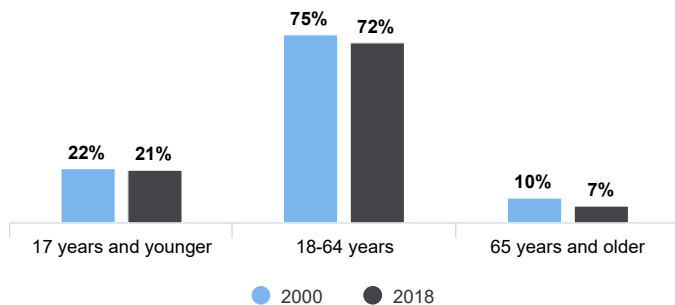
Total population



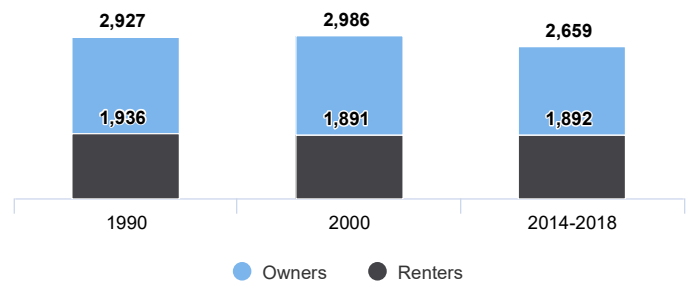
Population by race/ethnicity



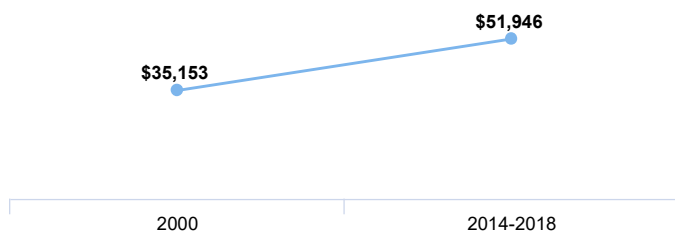
Population by age



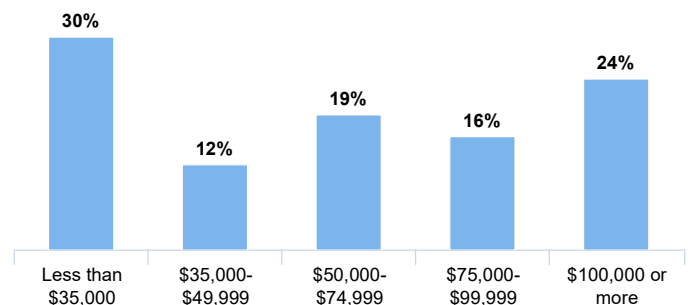
Households by tenure

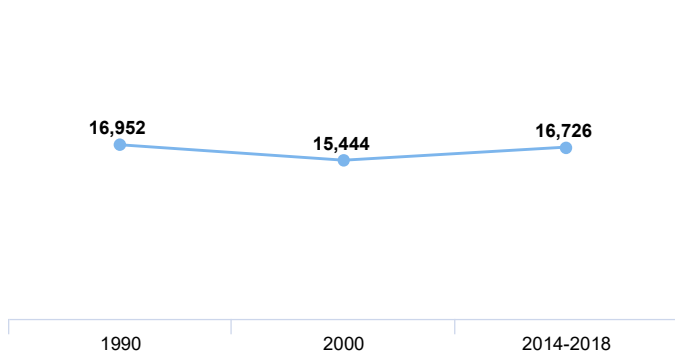

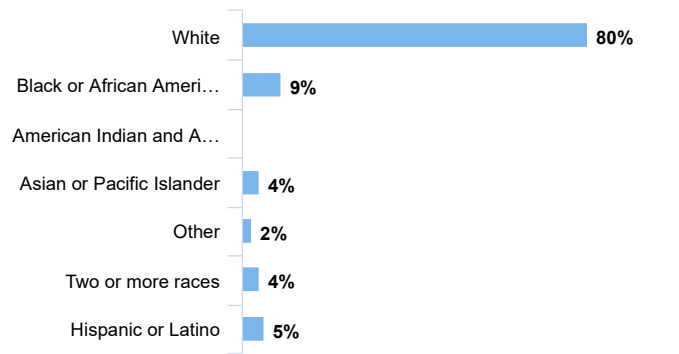

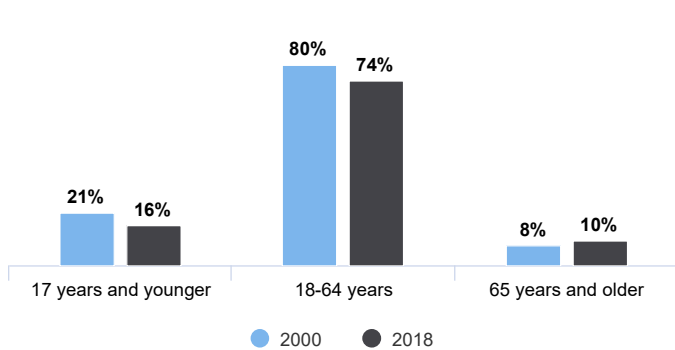
Total population



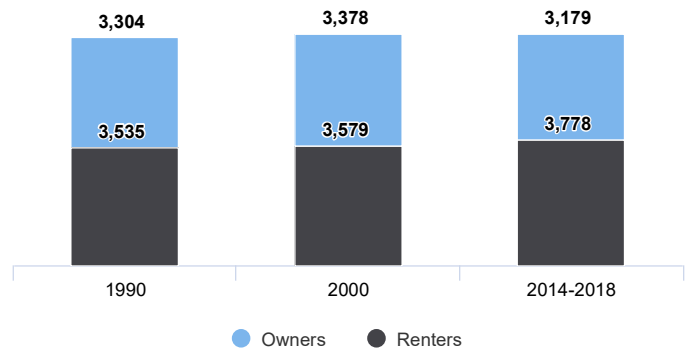
Population by race/ethnicity



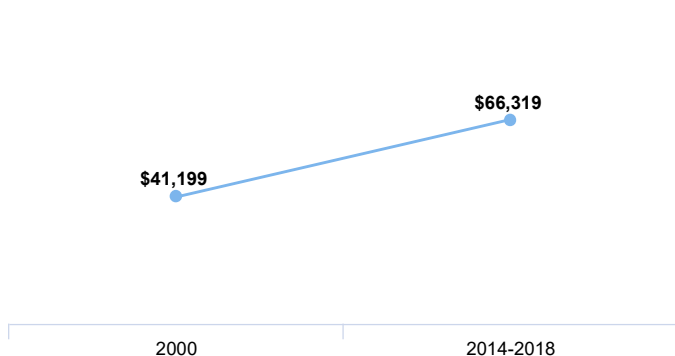
Population by age



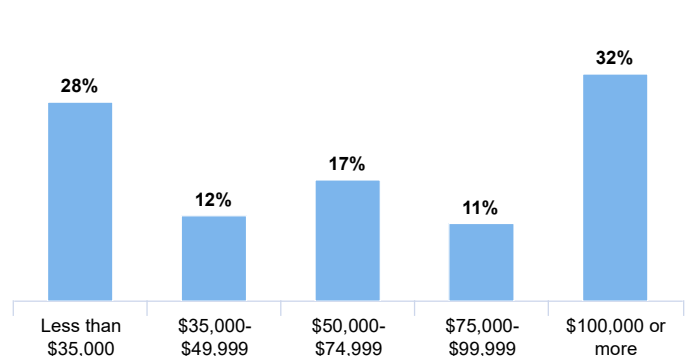
Households by tenure
