Dear Ms. Cyrus, Mr. Xiong, Ms. Carney and Mr. Schuenke:

This is to confirm that on October 20, 2020 at the Legislative Hearing, Marcia Moermond, the Legislative Hearing Officer recommended at the October 21, 2020 City Council meeting that the City Council grant a stay of enforcement pending the outcome of an Emergency Tenant Remedy Action (ETRA) until November 4, 2020 to allow for the potential repair or replacement of the heating system under court order. This stay is granted on the condition that the space heaters continue to be operated per manufacturer's instructions, with proper clearances and only with people present and attending to their operation.

I have included a copy of the resolution that went before Council for your reference. The City Council referred this matter back to Legislative Hearing for further discussion and an update on conditions on November 3, 2020 between 11:30 a.m. and 12:30 p.m. This hearing will take place via phone.
