IMPORTANT NOTICE: Deadlines for completing documentation are quickly approaching

For a property to be listed in the National Register of Historic Places prior to the Minnesota Historic Structure Rehabilitation Tax Credit sunset date (June 30, 2021), nominations need to be scheduled for a State Review Board meeting in early 2021.

Submission deadlines for February 16, 2021 meeting

Depending on the location of your building and the current designation status, one of the following scenarios will apply:

- If the property is within a Certified Local Government (CLG), a complete nomination packet must be submitted to SHPO on or before **November 10, 2020**;
- If the property is not within a CLG, a complete nomination packet must be submitted to SHPO on or before **December 8, 2020**.

A complete nomination package includes a nomination and its corresponding additional information, all of which has been reviewed by the SHPO and found acceptable. (Important note: preparing a nomination is a complex process and a draft nomination will typically go through several reviews before it is considered complete). Nominations are reviewed in the order received. If a nomination arrives after the above stated submission date and/or is not complete, we cannot guarantee it will be placed on the review board agenda. If the nomination is not included in the February meeting agenda, please contact National Register staff to discuss inclusion in future meetings.

Buildings must be listed in order to [obtain an Allocation Certificate](https://mn.gov/admin/shpo/incentives/state/) (<https://mn.gov/admin/shpo/incentives/state/>).
