Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

- 1. Front Storm door SPLC 34.09 (4), 34.33 (3) -Provide or repair and maintain the window screen.-
- 2. ATTIC SPLC 34.23, MSFC 110.1 This occupancy is condemned as unsafe AND dangerous. This occupancy must not be used until re-inspected and approved by this office. egress WINDOWS BLOCKED-

- 3. Attic SPLC 34.13 (1) Provide and maintain all habitable areas with a ceiling height of 7 feet over half the floor area.-
- 4. Attic MSFC 1030.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room or area, or discontinue use of area as a sleeping room. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.-Both windows are blocked
- 5. Rear exit door MSFC 1008.1.9.3 Remove unapproved locks from the unit doors. The door must be openable from the inside without the use of keys or special knowledge or effort.-
- 6. Upstairs Bedroom SPLC 34.09 (4), 34.33 (3) Repair and maintain the window glass.-
- 7. Various locations MSFC 605.4 Discontinue use of all multi-plug adapters.-
- 8. Various locations MSFC 605.5 Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.-
- 9. MSBC 1300.022 Subp. 3 The occupancy group or use division of this building has been changed from that previously approved. Discontinue the unapproved occupancy or use, or contact the Building Official at 651-266-8989 with your code analysis and to comply with requirements for approved occupancy.-
- 10. SPLC 34.09 (4), 34.33 (3) Repair and maintain the window sash.-
- 11. SPLC 62.101 Use of this property does not conform to zoning ordinance. Discontinue unapproved use or call DSI Zoning at (651) 266-8989 to convert to legal use. Discontinue: As a sober house-
- 12. MSFC 315.3.3 Remove combustible storage within 36 inches of fuel burning equipment.-
- 13. MSFC 603.5.3 Provide clearance around all mechanical equipment.-
- 14. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
