NOTICE OF CONDEMNATION UNFIT FOR HUMAN HABITATION ORDER TO VACATE

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on April 23, 2019.

The building was found to be unsafe, unfit for human habitation, a public nuisance, a hazard to the public welfare or otherwise dangerous to human life. A Condemnation Placard has been posted on the building.

The following deficiency list must be completed or the building vacated by the re-inspection date.

CONDEMNATION OF THE BUILDING REVOKES THE CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY.

Failure to complete the corrections may result in a criminal citation. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Exit door southside - SPLC 34.33 (3) - Repair and maintain the door in good condition.-
- 2. SPLC 163.03, 163.01 (2), (3) - Currently license (tabs) all vehicles on the property and return the vehicles to an operative mechanical condition or remove vehicles from the property.-

- 3. SPLC 34.09 (4), 34.33 (3) Repair and maintain the window glass.-
- 4. SPLC 34.09 (4), 34.33 (3) -Provide or repair and maintain the window screen.-
- 5. SPLC 34.34 (4), Sanitation The interior shall be maintained free from accumulation of refuse or garbage which constitutes an unsanitary, unsafe nuisance or hazardous condition.-
- 6. SPLC 34.11(5), 34.35(2), MPC 408.3 Provide adequate hot water between 110 degrees F and 120 degrees F.-
- 7. SPLC 34.11(4), 34.35(1), MPC 601.1 Provide an adequate water supply to all water closets, sinks, showers and tubs.-
- 8. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
