I'm writing in regards to assessments that may be brought against my property. Copies of the notices are provided. Three years ago my son whom I consider^a mentally challenged adult separated from his wife and moved back home.

He got in contact with a company that would drop off electronics behind and next to my garage. I was unaware until it arrived. My wife and I tried to stop this. In fact she called the city last winter to report illegal dumping on our property. All that did was bring the city inspector out to take pictures and send a notice to clean it up. Which I did. Then the company did it again the next month. This time my wife confronted the person the electronics off and threatened to call the police. They finally got the message and they have not been back. Anytime I got a notice I complied.

Tragedy struck in March. My son's wife Elizabeth Perry Lynch shot and killed her live-in boyfriend! You can verify this with the Hector, MN police or Renneville county courthouse.

The reason I mention this is that I now have 5 grandchildren ages 6-16 living with me. I'm the only one working in the household.

I'm ~~not~~ not receiving any financial assistance from city, county, state or federal government.

As an essential worker I have not received any unemployment or the \$600 that went with it. The only covid pay I get is 2 minutes per day to have my temp checked. Also if my place of employment shuts down I won't be receiving the extra \$600.

What I'm asking for is some ^{COMPASSION} ~~compassion~~ considering my situation.

Finally I want to mention overzealousness of an inspector. On May 1 I got a correction notice for my tan bond. NOTICE ENCLOSED as for my inoperable car I drove to work that day and parked it on the street that night. Tabs were not expired their good until October 31, 2020. Got them last October. You can check with the DMV. In order to get tabs car needs insurance, I've never taken the insurance off the car in the last 2 years.
