



PRODUCTION - CONSUMPTION - REVENUE


## SAINT PAUL REGIONAL WATER SERVICES YEAR TO DATE PRODUCTION



# SAINT PAUL REGIONAL WATER SERVICES PRODUCTION BY MONTH




## SAINT PAUL REGIONAL WATER SERVICES YEAR TO DATE CONSUMPTION
