Re: Remove or Repair of the Structure at 1313 Seminary Avenue

Dear Ms. Allred & Mr. Wilson:

This is to confirm that on December 22, 2020 at the Legislative Hearing, Marcia Moermond, stated that she will recommend at the January 13, 2021 City Council meeting that they refer the matter back to Legislative Hearing **Tuesday**, **February 9, 2021 between 9:00 and 11:00 am via phone** for further discussion.

Again, in order to rehabilitate the property the following conditions must be met in order to receive a grant of time from the City Council for rehabilitation of the property, and will be needed prior to the next February 17, 2021 Council Public Hearing:

- 1. Property owner and mortgage holder must work with DSI code compliance team to get code compliance inspection completed (note Inspector Bruhn indicated the importance of cleaning out the property in order to complete the inspections. Mr. Wilson and Ms. Allred should be present for the next inspection to provide safe, supervised access to property);
- 2. post a \$5,000 performance deposit with the Department of Safety & Inspections (DSI);
- 3. submit evidence of financing sufficient to complete the rehabilitation. Staff estimates a cost of \$75,000. If total for bids are more than 20% less than staff estimate, a high level of detail will be required. Financing could be business or personal accounts, a line of credit, or construction loan. Other types of financing will be reviewed on a case by case basis;
- 4. submit an affidavit indicating the finances will be dedicated to completing the project and not diverted until a code compliance certificate is issued;

- 5. submit work plan, sworn construction statement, or scope of work. This should include subcontractor bids and a schedule for completion of the project; and
- 6. the property must be maintained.
