The Abatement Order in question was dated and mailed Monday, February 8th, 2021, and delivered sometime on Wednesday, or possibly late Tuesday. The "**Comply before**" date on the order is February 15, 2021. I think that this date is reasonable for the work on the front porch and yard, despite the frequent wind chill advisories that have been issued because the ordered work is not very onerous and because that part of the property faces south and gets some sunshine, and also is sheltered from the North and Northwesterly winds. I fully intend, and expect, to complete that part of the work over the holiday weekend. The back yard, especially the lumber, is different. It is colder, has deeper snow, gets much more wind and little sunshine. Even so, I can complete part of the order, about removing scrap wood, and that part of "miscellaneous debris" that is visible above the snow.

But the lumber, which is arguably improperly stored, at least since some high winds tore the tarps covering it to shreds earlier this season, the lumber is now stuck in heaps of snow and ice.

I want to salvage some of it, and can do so myself when the weather is warmer. So I want an extension on the "Comply before" date for that part of the work.

If you do not correct the nuisance or file an appeal before February 15, 2021, the City will correct the nuisance and charge all cost, including boarding costs, against the property as a special assessement to be collected in the same way as property taxes. Charges: If the City corrects the nuisance, the charges will include the cost of correction, inspection, travel time, equipment, etc. The rate will be approximately \$260 per hour plus expenses for abatement.

APPEALS:You may appeal this order and obtain a hearing before the Legislative Hearing Officer by completing an appeal application before the deadline noted above or seven (7) days after the date mailed, whichever comes first. No appeals may be filed after that date. You may obtain an appeal application from the City Clerk's Office, Room 310 City Hall, 15 W. Kellogg Blvd., St. Paul, MN 55102. (651) 266-8688. You must submit a copy of this Order with your appeal application.
