Dear Mr. Schilling & Mr. Bowen:

This is to confirm that at the City Council meeting on March 10, 2021 Marcia Moermond, Legislative Hearing Officer, recommended they grant an additional 180 days, to September 8, 2021, for the removal or repair of the structure in the above matter.

At the conclusion of the 180-day grant of time, the Council will receive a report from the Legislative Hearing Officer with findings on the status of the substantial abatement and a Legislative Hearing is scheduled for **Tuesday, September 14, 2021 at 10 a.m. Depending on Covid rules and status, that hearing may be in person or via phone.** At this time, owners, interested parties, and Department of Safety and Inspection staff will present information on the current building conditions and progress toward abatement of the dangerous/nuisance conditions and the resulting findings will be presented to the City Council at a public hearing on **Wednesday, October 6, 2021 at 3:30 p.m.** for its consideration.
