NOTICE OF CONDEMNATION UNFIT FOR HUMAN HABITATION ORDER TO VACATE

RE: 1094 KENT ST Ref. # 101870

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on February 12, 2021.

The building was found to be unsafe, unfit for human habitation, a public nuisance, a hazard to the public welfare or otherwise dangerous to human life. A Condemnation Placard has been posted on the building.

The following deficiency list must be completed, or the building vacated by the re-inspection date.

A reinspection will be made on or after March 15, 2021.

CONDEMNATION OF THE BUILDING REVOKES THE CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY.

Failure to complete the corrections may result in a criminal citation. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy.

DEFICIENCY LIST

1. Interior - Basement - SPLC 34.11 (1), MSBC 2902.1, SPLC 34.35 (1), MPC 301.1 - Repair or replace and maintain all parts of the plumbing system to an operational condition. - **Broken waterline in basement.**

- 2. Interior Throughout MSFC 605.4 Discontinue use of all multi-plug adapters. **Remove multi plugs.**
- 3. Interior Throughout MSFC 605.5 Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring. -Remove extension cords.
- 4. Interior Throughout MN Stat 299F.18 Immediately remove and discontinue excessive accumulation of combustible materials. -Remove excessive materials in basement and throughout.
- 5. Interior Throughout SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.17 (5) Repair and maintain the walls in an approved manner. -**Repair holes in walls.**
- 6. Interior Throughout SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.17 (5) Repair and maintain the ceiling in an approved manner. **-Repair ceiling holes.**
- 7. Interior Throughout SPLC 34.23, MSFC 110.1 This occupancy is condemned as unfit for human habitation. This occupancy must not be used until re-inspected and approved by this office. -This property is condemned for the following:
- Excessive accumulation of combustible materials. Reduce by 90%
- Deterioration and holes in interior walls and ceilings.
- Uncapped and open electrical wiring
- 8. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
