This is to confirm that on March 23, 2021 at the Legislative Hearing, Marcia Moermond, the Legislative Hearing Officer recommended **denying your appeal of the vacant building registration.** As discussed in the hearing, <u>do not pay this fee so it is processed as an assessment.</u> Please appeal that assessment, so you can discuss the possibility of prorating the fee with Ms. Moermond.

The City Council Public Hearing is scheduled for April 14, 2021 at 3:30 p.m. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, we will not be holding hearings in person. If you are contesting Ms. Moermond's recommendation, you may send written testimony to be added to the record to legislativehearings@ci.stpaul.mn.us or by voicemail at 651-266-6805. If you don't wish to contest, no further action is needed.

As discussed in the hearing, the property will need a code compliance inspection before it can be transferred (in lieu of a TISH).
