NARRATIVE

On 11/10/20 at 2346 hours, I Squad 111 (M.Johnson/S.Jones) responded to 1150 Central Ave on the report of someone attempting to kick in the rear door the address.

Upon arrival on scene, Officers located two people in the alley walking east bound from the direction of 1150 Central. Jasiah Sadae Lavera Young (DOB/1996-09-30) and Willie Sutton III (DOB/1982-05-31) were both detained on scene while Officers spoke with the complainant. Both parties stated they were coming from a different address at the time they were stopped by Officers.

I then spoke with Miguel Angel Lopez (DOB:4/14/77, C/P:651-338-5157) who stated that he had been at his address of 1154 Central Ave when he heard a loud banging sound coming from the alleyway and rear of 1150 Central Ave.

He stated that when he looked outside he saw a male dressed all in black attempting to kick in the rear door of 1150 Central. He also stated that a female that was wrapped in a blanket was standing nearby the suspect male as he kicked at the door. It should be noted that YOUNG was wrapped in a blanket at the time she was stopped by Officers.

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Lopez stated that he would not be able to identify the party kicking at the door as it was too dark to see when he had looked outside.

It should be noted that SUTTON was not dressed in all black and did not match the limited description given by Lopez.

Lopez also stated that 1150 Central has been vacant for "a couple weeks" after there had been a fire at the address. He stated that owner of the address had been renting it out prior to the fire, however no one had been living in it on the main or upper floor for at least two weeks as there was too much fire damage. Lopez provided me with the property owners name and phone # (Matt C/P:651-485-2121). I attempted to contact Matt with negative results.

While on scene we found that the rear door to 1150 Central had damage to the door jam. Photos of damage to the door were taken on scene and uploaded to the SPPD media vault. The scene was processed by Officers on scene.

Due to the fact that the two parties that were detained did not match the description and that the complainant could not identify a suspect, both SUTTON and YOUNG were released on scene.

Squad 101 (Sgt Kowalski) was notified.

Board up crew was notified and responded to the address to secure the rear door.

NARRATIVE

I, Sgt. Biermaier, am assigned to the Western District Investigations Unit and reviewed this report. I am responsible for investigating persons, property and organized retail crime offenses within the City of Saint Paul. In addition, I initiate numerous follow-up investigations based on arrests by patrol officers and assist and

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cooperate with outside agencies as necessary. I was assigned this case for review and investigation. I began by reviewing the included reports and information, as well as any pictures if applicable. The reports on the parties involved were reviewed to determine the course of investigation, as well as the level and probability of solvability. This is all done for information gathering purposes, as well as possible future criminal charges.

I reviewed the report written by the officers and read that the two individuals that were detained did not match the description of the suspects. The complainant informed the officers that he would not be able to identify the suspects due to it being dark outside when he heard the noises.

The officers processed the scene and took photographs of the door.

I spoke on the phone with the building owner, JULIE BECHTEL (763-438-3349), and she told me that the building is her rental property, but the unit is vacant due to a recent fire. I informed BECHTEL that there was not a witness to the incident, just a complainant who heard the noises. I informed BECHTEL that the two persons detained did not match the suspect descriptions and the complainant couldn't positively identify the suspect. BECHTEL said that there was no working cameras on the building.

I explained to BECHTEL that this case would be pended until additional information was obtained and a suspect could be identified. I gave BECHTEL the case number for her records.
