

In the month since we talked...

- Case rates have plateaued locally, with hospitalization and death rates declining (likely associated with ~65% of our community receiving at least one dose of vaccine)
- Positivity rates are still too high (likely associated with reopening businesses and an age-based rollout)
- JJJ 'pause' ended, but damage is done
- FEMA site launched
- EUA for Pfizer (12- to 15-year-olds) on the horizon

Fairgrounds vaccine site update

- Focus of this FEMA/State community vaccination center is to provide no barrier vaccination opportunities for Minnesotans.
- Goal: Vaccinate 105,000/84,000 Minnesotans in priority zip codes over 8 weeks
 - As of May 4, more than 40,000 Minnesotans have gotten their first shot here
