NARRATIVE

On 01/17/2021 at approximately 0038 hours, we (Squad 112, Leistikow/Piram) responded to an alarm call at 1190 University Ave W (Caliber Collision). Upon arrival, we found a broken window on the east side of the building where it appeared someone likely made entry into the building. Officer Yunker (Canine Squad 634) arrived on scene shortly after and we cleared the building. No one was found in the building and we did not find any further damage inside. The keyholder, Schaffer, Craig, was called but there was no response. It is unknown at this time if anything was taken from the building. We left the case number for the incident on the front desk of the business. Photos were taken of the damaged window and later uploaded to the media vault. We processed the scene with negative results. Restoration Professionals were called and they secured the broken window. Nothing further at this time.

NARRATIVE

I, Sergeant Fink, am assigned to the Burglary Unit for the St. Paul Police Department. I have been assigned this case for review and investigation. I reviewed all initial reports, information, and any pictures, if taken by officers or investigators. The reports on all parties involved were reviewed to determine the course of investigation, as well as the level and probability of solvability. This is all done for information gathering purposes, as well as possible future criminal charges.

I called and spoke to Schaffer, Craig regarding this case. Schaffer said there is no video but they are putting in cameras on Thursday. He said that it does not appear that anyone got into the building on this attempt. He said there are no signs that someone came through the broken window and that broken glass was still hanging inside the window and someone would have had to knock it out to crawl through.

At this time there are no solvability factors to move forward on. This case will be pended until further info becomes availab

NARRATIVE

Sqd 634(Yunker) responded to 1190 University Ave to assist west officers who responded to a burglary alarm and had found forced entry.

I arrived on scene and confirmed there was in fact a large broken window and entry had clearly been made into the business and it was unknown whether there were still possible suspects inside. I had been to a burglary here in the last year where the suspect took vehicles. I deployed my canine partner on 20 foot lead and went to the entry point. I made two loud verbal canine warnings into the business with no response. I searched the entire first floor locating no one inside. I then went to the second level where I made two more canine warnings verbally with no response. I then cleared the second floor finding no one either. I then cleared the scene.
