ARTICLE 6 – PROBATIONARY PERIODS

- All personnel, originally hired or rehired following separation, in a regular employment status shall serve a six (6) month probationary period during which time the employee's fitness and ability to perform the position's duties and responsibilities shall be evaluated. Employee's hired after **May 1, 2021** shall serve a one (1) year 2080 hour probationary period.
- All personnel promoted to a higher class shall serve a six (6) month promotional probationary period during which time the employee's fitness and ability to perform the position's duties and responsibilities shall be evaluated. Employee's hired after **May 1, 2021** shall serve a one (1) year 2080 hour probationary period.

APPENDIX D

Effective May 1, 2021 (or closest pay period) the Employer shall:

Deduct \$3.71 per hour to a Union designated fund for all hours worked to employees. A payroll deduction in this amount shall be made from the hourly rates listed in Appendix C.

Hired PRIOR to July 1, 2020 (or closest pay period): Contribute \$28.94 per hour to a Union designated fund for all hours worked to employees.

Hired AFTER July 1, 2020 (or closest pay period): Contribute \$31.44 per hour to a Union designated fund for all hours worked to employees.

Hired PRIOR to July 1, 2020 (or closest pay period): Contribute \$3.50 per hour to the **Supplemental Pension Fund** for all hours worked by participating employees.

Hired AFTER July 1, 2020 (or closest pay period): Contribute **\$6.00** per hour to the **Supplemental Pension Fund** for all hours worked by participating employees.
