Re: Appeal for Property at 1834 Hoyt Avenue East

Dear Ms. Warnke & Ms. Smith:

This is to confirm that on May 28, 2021 at the Legislative Hearing, Legislative Hearing Officer Marcia Moermond recommended that the City Council **deny your appeal of the condemnation and order to vacate orders.** The property should currently be empty, as it was to be vacated before Tuesday, June 2, 2021. The property cannot be reoccupied until the following conditions are met:

- 1) electrical work completed under permit and all necessary permit(s) finaled;
- 2) 50% of excess storage must be removed to reduce fire load and provide access to escape and emergency egress; and
- 3) gas line and dryer vent work must be completed and all necessary permit(s) finaled.

These conditions must be met **before July 14, 2021** or the property will be referred to the Vacant Building program as a Category 2 vacant building and subject to all program requirements before it can be reoccupied.

As discussed in the hearing, I have attached the police call log since January of 2020. A copy of the Ramsey County House Calls brochure was emailed to you last Friday, May 28, but is attached here again as well.
