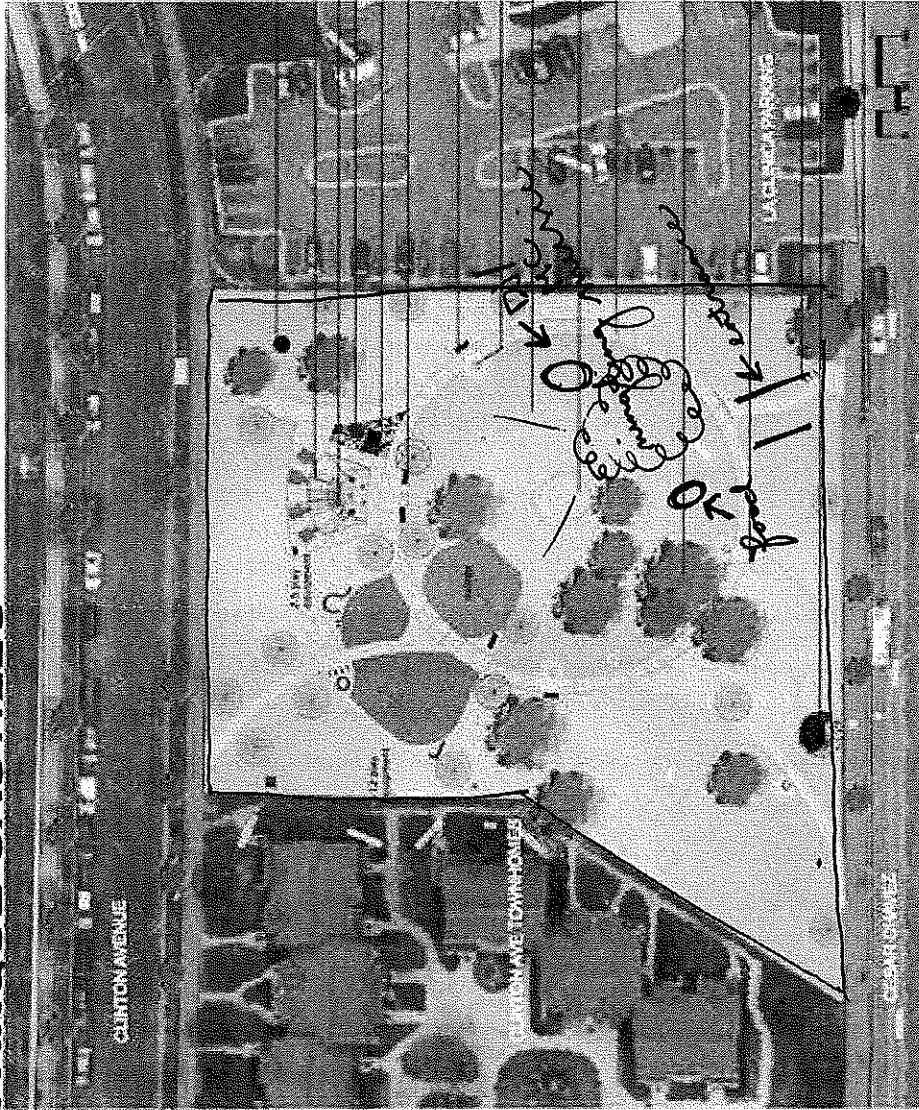

CONCEPT PLAN

A circle is the symbol of unity, wholeness, inclusion and infinity; this form inspires the geometry for the new design of Parque Castillo. A new circular pathway facilitates circulation throughout the park, creates a shared central space for community gatherings, and connects the new elements of the park: a play area, splashpad, seating, and pathways into the central area. The concept plan creates an active zone at the north side of the park; the play area creates play space for age group and solo play; splashpad creates a splashpad play area for water play and to create a flexible entertainment space where the water features are turned off. Pathways from Clanton Avenue are across from the field project. A picnic area is located near the splashpad. The stage remains in the center of the circle for informal performances.
