As owner or person(s) responsible for: 2078 BUSH AVE you are hereby ordered to eliminate all nuisance conditions which are in violation of Chapter 45 of Saint Paul Legislative Code.

1. Cut and remove any overgrown vegetation (including trees) impeding public right of way, sidewalk, blvd, and alley areas. Public sidewalks must be cleared edge- to- edge and up to seven (7) feet in height. Alleys and streets must be cleared from edge- to- edge and up to fourteen (14) feet in height.

PLEASE CUT AND REMOVE ALL PLANT GROWTH AND VEGETATION HANGING INTO THE RIGHT OF WAY TO A CLEAR HEIGHT OF FOURTEEN FEET. THANK YOU. Comply before May 27, 2021

If you do not correct the nuisance or file an appeal **before May 27, 2021**, the City will correct the nuisance and charge all costs, including boarding costs, against the property as a special assessment to be collected in the same way as property taxes.

<u>Charges</u>: If the City corrects the nuisance, the charges will include the cost of correction, inspection, travel time, equipments, etc. The rate will be approximately \$260 per hour plus expensed for abatement.

You must maintain the premises in a clean condition and provide proper and adequate refuse storage at all times FAILURE TO COMPLY MAY RESULT IN A CRIMINAL CITATION
