Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- Sec. 40.01. Fire certificate of occupancy requirement. 1.
- (a) All existing buildings in the city are required to have and maintain a fire certificate of occupancy, issued by the department of safety and inspections. The fire certificate of occupancy shall be an indication that the building meets, at the time of inspection, all relevant codes to maintain the health, safety and welfare of the building's occupants and the general public. -Occupant is not registered as the owner of record with Ramsey County tax. Immediately complete the application for a Fire Certificate of Occupancy along with the required provisional fee.
- 2. SPLC 34.19 - Provide access to the inspector to all areas of the building. Allow the inspector full access to the dwelling and garage on April 30, 2021 at 11:00 a.m.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
