At the February 24 January 20, 2021 hearing, Ms. Moermond will recommend reduce the assessment from \$452 to \$226. That happens no matter what. Then, she will also ask that they continue the Public hearing to July 21, 2021 and if there are no same or similar violations at that time, will recommend that the Council delete the assessment entirely.

Nothing will need to be paid until after the July 21, 2021 city council meeting. If there are violations between now and July 21, then they will be assessed for the \$226.
