

A Resolution extending the time to review the amendment to Section 6.03 of the Saint Paul Charter for 90 days.

WHEREAS, on May 19, 2021, in Council Resolution RES 21-720, the Saint Paul City Council requested that the Charter Commission recommend certain changes to Section 6.03 of the Saint Paul City Charter; and

WHEREAS, such proposal was submitted to the Charter Commission on June 1, 2021; and

WHEREAS, under Minn. Stat. § 410.12, subd. 5, the Charter Commission has 60 days to consider such proposal but may extend that time to review proposed changes for an additional 90 days “by filing with the city clerk its resolution determining that an additional time for review is needed”; and

WHEREAS, the sixty-day deadline will expire on July 31, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Charter Commission seeks to extend this deadline in order to ensure there is sufficient time to consider the proposed amendment and allow for public input; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Charter Commission directs staff to submit this resolution to the City Clerk declaring that additional time for review of the proposed changes to Charter Section 6.03 is needed and extending the time for review for an additional 90 days until October 29, 2021.
